
The data was collected and analyzed by IQAC. In general positive feedback was received as all the Stakeholders expressed satisfaction with respect to content and design of curriculum.



1) Satisfactory level of ideas in the content of syllabus





2) Skills/competency acquired after completion of the syllabus





3) Allotment to the credit to the courses





4) Effectiveness of the subject focusing on the latest technologies advancement





5) Inquisitiveness for external learning or self-learning in the syllabus





On an average 41.5% are Exhalent, 32% are very good, 21% are good, 4% are average and 1.5% are poor with Overall quality of scheme and syllabus.




















Conclusion

Alumni are satisfied with the course content and skill development opportunities but suggested revising the curriculum to include more industrial applications.



















CONCLUSION
